Nursery Learn about Animals

This week Nursery have been reading 'Abigail' and learning about some of the animals in the story. we have explored the various prints of the animals and matched them, and we have had lots of amazing artwork from the children.

This week Reception have been learning about 'The blue balloon'. The children enjoyed writing our wondrous words, painted their own balloons and ordered the balloons based on their size. Year 1 'The Feeding of the 5000'

This half term Year 1 have been learning about Harvest in their RE lessons. In their lesson this week, Year 1 learned about 'The Feeding of the 5000'. Year 6 Law of Reflection

Year 6 have continued learning about 'light' in their science unit. The children furthered their knowledge and learning from previous lessons where they learnt that light travels in straight lines. This lesson, the children learnt about the law of reflection and how the angle of incidence is always equal to the angle of reflection. We used card, mirrors and a torch to demonstrate this in an investigation, before drawing a diagram in our books to explain our findings.
