


Hello Reception,

I hope you all had a great day celebrating 75 years of VE day? Here are some of your preparations from during the week and I look forward to seeing more soon too:



We've been learning lots about animals in the wild and their natural environment. What about the same animals that live in zoos? Do you know why they live there in captivity? 

I've also set you a task on Purple Mash task all about birthdays too, as I know some of you love completing these.



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
Art and Design/Computing





We've considered the job of a safari ranger and even dressed up as one! Now can you design a vehicle for them to get around in to check on the animals? What design features will you need to consider? Research some real safari trucks online, you will need to make sure it keeps the passengers safe and blends in well with the surroundings.

Use Purple Mash to design it - you can see what it will look like in 3D using the software and get a net image too. Next week we will use these designs to make it into reality! So, whatever you design this week, you have a chance to gather anything you might need to make it.

Activity 3: Obstacles – use items from your house to avoid when running and then with an intercepting ball!








Try something new...
