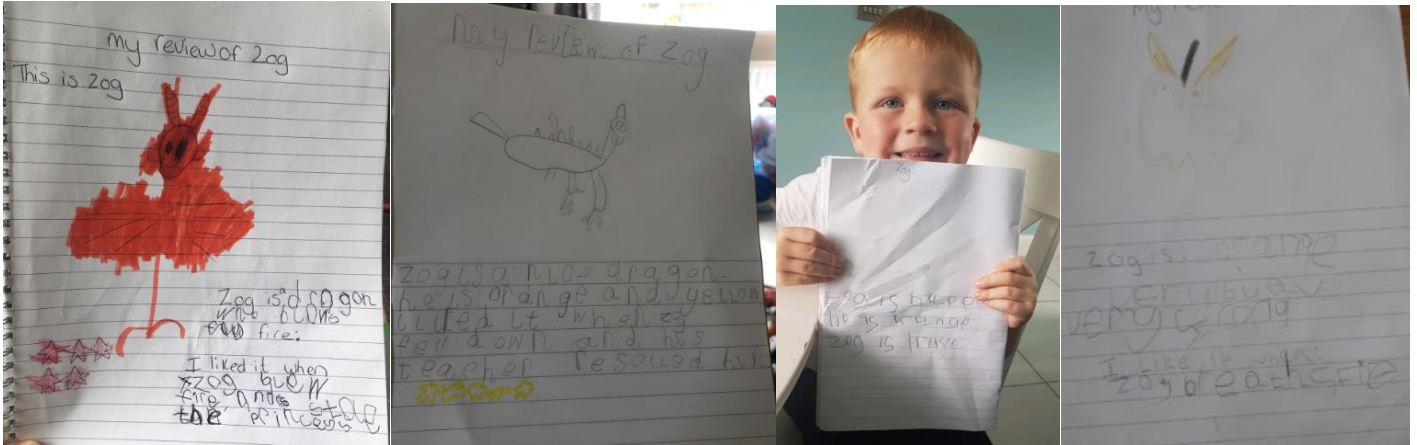


Hello Reception,

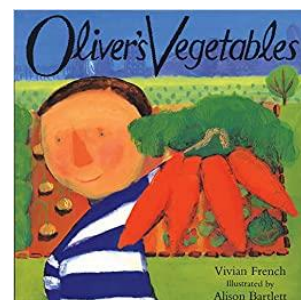
Day 1: Complex patterns - learn about and make circular and border patterns.

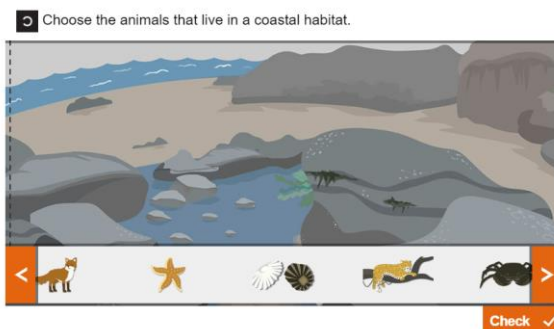
