


RECEPTION HOME LEARNING

Maths

This week we will be using White Rose Maths, with Oliver's Vegetables.





<u>Day 1: Complex patterns - learn</u> about and make circular and border patterns.

<u>Day 4: Help Oliver to label</u> <u>his crop</u> It's been a bumper crop! Help to label the amounts with numbers. Day 2: Addition memory game - play 'I went to the market' and list items of vegetables from Oliver's garden.

<u>Day 5: Milkshake doubles</u> Oliver's friend has come over, can you double the ingredients he needs?

<u>Day 3: Count Oliver's</u> <u>vegetables</u> <u>Can</u> you find out how many more he needs?


Oliver and his vegetables continue into Literacy this week. You can find a copy to read on YouTube and I will share files to support you this week on Class Dojo daily that we're using in class.
