Reading and writing

Search around your house and see if you can find a noun starting with every letter of the alphabet. I have made a start to help you:

- A apple
- B bed

C – carpet

Lesson 2 – I have set you a 2Do on Purple Mash called 'Name Nouns'. Choose the letter that begins either your first or last name. I chose 'W' as it is the first letter of my surname. See how many nouns you can think of that begin with that letter and earn yourself some class dojo points!

1-5 nouns = 1 dojo point

6-10 nouns = 2 dojo points

11-15 nouns = 3 dojo points

16 - 20 nouns = 4 dojo points

More than 20 nouns = 5 dojo points!



Lesson 3 – I have set you a 2Do on purple mash called 'compound nouns'.

Compound nouns are where two words that are nouns join together to make one word.

e.g. foot and ball = football, fish and bowl = fishbowl

Complete the matching game I have set for you on Purple Mash by turning over two cards at time to find the matching pairs!



Write a list of all the compound nouns you make on the game in your workbook. Can you think of any of your own?

Write three sentences containing compound nouns.

Science



Last week you carried out the sink or float experiment to see what happened to objects when you placed them on water. This week I would like you to make a boat and test it to see how much weight you have to put on it before it sinks.

Here is a link to show you how to make a boat out of paper. You might have to ask somebody in your house to help you as it is quite tricky!

Fill a large container with water and put your paper boat on the water. Once piece at a time put a coin on your boat and see if it stays afloat or if it sinks. Keep count of the number of coins on your boat. How many coins do you think it will take to make your boat sink?

Don't worry if you don't have any coins. You could use Lego bricks, pieces of pasta, pebbles or something else.

Record how many objects it took to sink your paper boat.

Once you have done this, repeat the experiment but this time make a boat out of tin foil.

How many objects did it take to sink your tin foil boat?

Which boat was able to carry the most weight? Why do you think this was?
