Activity 1

Create a collage of a seaside scene using cuttings from magazines and catalogues. Think about the colors you will need to create a seaside scene.

Activity 2

Make a 3D sea animal. You can use any material you like. You could use papier mâché, junk modelling materials, clay, play dough or even Lego.

Activity 3

With an adult, use the internet to research famous artists who use the beach for inspiration. What do you think of their work? Can you tell that they were inspired by the beach?

4 points

Activity 4

Make a miniature seashore garden using pebbles, twigs, sand and shells. If you can, visit a beach to collect your materials.

4 points

Activity 5

Make your own word search with all the names of living things that you would find at the beach or in the sea. Ask your family to have a go. Can they solve your word search?

4 Points

Activity 6

Write a poem about the living things that make their home in a rock pool. Can you make an acrostic or shape poem?

5 Points

Activity 7

Make a list of all of the activities you could do at the seashore. Survey your family to find out what they most like to do at the beach and create a pictogram or bar chart to show your findings.

Activity 8

With an adult, create a healthy picnic that you could take to the beach to eat. If you can't get to the beach, you could enjoy your picnic in the garden or even on the living room floor!

5 points

Activity 9

Create your own seaside gift shop, make price labels to put on the things you could sell and then find different combinations of coins that you could use to pay for the things in your shop. Record this in your book.

4 points

Activity 10

Design, draw or paint a picture of a beach hut. What colours are you going to use?

3 points

Activity 11

Write a postcard that you could send someone after a day at the beach. What will you tell them about your day? What did you do? What did you eat? Did you see any wildlife?

5 points

Activity 12

Write a set of instructions telling someone how they can make a fantastic sandcastle on the beach. Remember to use numbers to structure your instructions and to write them in chronological order.
