#### **Nursery Fact Find about Owls!**

This week Nursery have been very busy fact finding and learning lots of new information about owls. We have worked together and built our own nests for the owlets in the construction area. The children thought it needed to be high so they wouldn't fall out of the nest. We have also done lots of other 'owl themed' activities from using real feathers in our art area to working on our fine motor skills.











#### **Reception Learn Road Safety**

This week Reception have been learning about how to cross the road safely. We talked about how important it is to hold our adult's hand so that we can stay safe on the road. The children learnt the steps to cross the road safely: 'Stop, look, listen, think.'







#### **Year 1 Create Personal Timelines**

Year 1 have been learning about Childhood in their topic lessons this half term. The class have used photos from home to create personal timelines that represents the stages of life they have experienced so far (baby, toddler, child). They have also learned about family trees and how each 'level' represents a different generation, with every family tree being different and unique. In our most recent lesson, the children asked the question 'How long ago was the 1950s?'. They learned about decades and created a timeline in groups to show important events that have happened in each decade from the 1950s to present day.











#### **Year 2 Cricket**

Year 2 have been enjoying their P.E. lessons so far this half term as they have moved onto Cricket. So far, we have learned fielding skills such as running and catching, and last lesson we moved on to batting.







# **Year 3 Coding**

In year 3 the class enjoyed continuing with their new computing topic of Coding. This week the lesson involved planning on whiteboards what scene they wanted to create. This could be people moving side to side and making objects such as the sun appear and disappear. They then acted this out so they knew exactly how their scene would look. Next it was time to use the iPads to create their work. Well done year 3 for working hard on such a complex computing topic!







# Year 4 Super Scientists!

The Super Scientists in Year 4 were classifying teeth this week. We learned the names of the different types of teeth and what they are for. We then tried to make our own set of teeth using mini marshmallows. They did a fantastic job!



### **Year 5 Working Conditions in Mines**

This week, in Topic, Year 5 have been learning about working conditions in the mines. We learned some shocking facts such as miners working 18-hour shifts, with some children working even longer. The children were asked to make notes on the topic in their books.



# Year 6 Learn all about Light

This week, in science, Year 6 have been learning all about light! We learnt that light travels in straight lines from a light source, it hits off an object and is reflected before travelling in a straight line to our eyes - this is how we see the object! In small groups, we used a torch and string to represent how light travels!
