<u>YEAR 2</u>

In their RE lessons this half term, Year 2 have been learning all about Christianity. We have explored the question of what the idea of 'peace' means to Christians and how they find this. We recently had a go at writing our very own prayers for something we are thankful for. The children read example prayers as a class and discussed what they were thankful for in their lives.







YEAR 3

This week, in Topic, Year 3 have been learning all about tsunamis. We learned that tsunamis are created when there is an earthquake under the sea. We discovered that they can be very destructive and can devastate the lives of people involved. After learning about what a tsunami is, we created our own in class.



<u>YEAR 4</u>

This week, Year 4 have focused on their art project, 'Wonderful Weaving.' We learned that weaving is an ancient method of joining two sets of threads together to form cloth. We practiced paper weaving before creating our own cardboard loom to thread the cloth onto. We created and made our own designs using multiple colours and worked incredibly hard showing resilience and perseverance when making mistakes. Miss Jackson was very impressed with how often we helped each other too!


