Maths



Please consolidate your ability to read time. This is crucial before we start to move on to problem solving as you must know how to read o'clock, quarter past, half past, quarter to, and the 5 minute intervals that

you can read on a clock face. You all know your 5x tables up to 60 so this should be a breeze! Concentrate on knowing that once we pass 6, the format changes from 'past' to 'to'.

Monday – Ensure you can read an analogue clock with confidence or with an adult. This week we are focusing on problem solving questions where you choose which ones you want to tackle. To be successful, the skill of reading the clock will be integral!

Tuesday – I have posted the problem-solving cards on our Class Dojo. Please choose 5 to answer today. There are 38 in total so look through and say them out loud to see which ones you think you can tackle!

Wednesday – Please use the problem-solving cards from yesterday and choose 5 more to answer today.





Thursday – For your final 5 problems of your choice, can you write them out neatly to explain your thinking process? Write a sentence about each problem to tell your adult why you came to that answer. They might have a different answer to you and will have to prove to you why they are right!

Tuesday - This website is fantastic for you to explore. Your job today is to pick 2 topics of your choice and write out all the information you can find out about it. Add a picture or do further searching (use kids in your search) to find out more.

Wednesday – Using the same site, can you pinpoint any information about what life was like for <u>women</u> only in Ancient Greece? Draw a woman in Ancient Greek dress and label her with the information you have retrieved.

Thursday - Using the same site, can you pinpoint any information about what life was like for <u>men</u> in Ancient Greece? Draw a man in Ancient Greek dress and label him with the information you have retrieved.

Friday – Can you write an argument as to whether you would rather live as an Ancient Greek man or an Ancient Greek woman? There are pros and cons to both arguments, and your job is to compare the positive and negatives and make a decision as to what your choice would be.
