


### **YEAR 2 HOME LEARNING -**

Use this link to read the story: The Myth of Pandora's box

**Lesson 1** – Read the first part of the story from page 4 to page 5.

Activity 1: What do you think the box looked like? There is no right or wrong answer, what do you imagine it would look like? Draw the box inside your workbook. Can you think of some adjectives (describing words) you could use to describe the box?

**Lesson 2** – reread the beginning of the story to remind yourself what has happened so far. After that, read the first paragraph on page 6. What do you think is going to be in the box?

Write a sentence telling me what you think will be in the box and why you think that. Try to use a range of adjectives to make your sentence exciting.

**Lesson 3** – reread the story so far and continue to read the story on page 7. Draw the evil monster that came out of the box. There is an example one drawn for you but your evil monster can look like whatever you want.

Write a character description for your monster. Think about his personality (what he is like inside) and his appearance (what he looks like). Remember to use adjectives to describe him. You could even use some verbs and adverbs to describe the way me moves. Does he slither slowly? Does he run quickly?

I am looking forward to seeing your drawings and descriptions of the evil monster on our class dojo!

**Lesson 4** – Read the whole story in one go and share it with an adult in your house. Write a book review for the story.

I have set you a 2Do on Purple Mash called 'Book Review'.

Try to include:

- The name of the story
- How many stars you would give it.
- What happened in the story
- Your opinion of the story. Did you like it? Why? Did you not like it? Why? Remember, it is ok not to like a story as long as you can give a reason for it.

- 5. What did Iris use to hide the lion?
- 6. Did this disguise work? Why? Why not?
- 7. Why was the bus not able to go back to school?
- 8. How did the children get back to school?
- 9. Why did the children never travel by bus again?
- 10. How do you think Miss Holland felt at the end of the story? Why?

Create a poster reminding people how to stay safe in the sun. Remember to use slip, slop, slap to help to remind people to stay safe!






## **Science and Design and Technology**
