Early Years

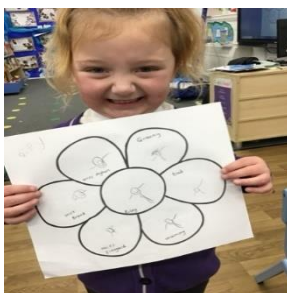
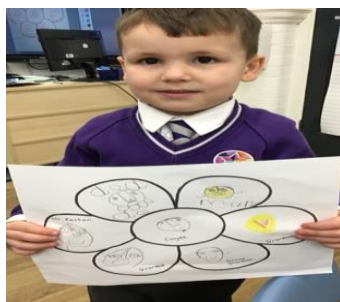
As a part of Safer Internet Day, Nursery and Reception worked together to discuss how the internet works, how we stay safe online and who our trusted adults are.

"I want them to come back and do it again" - Tommy





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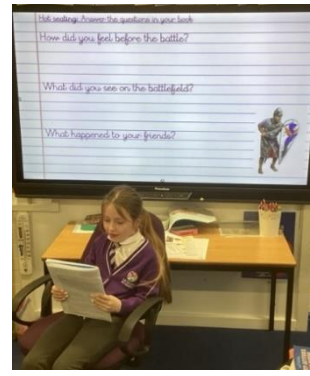
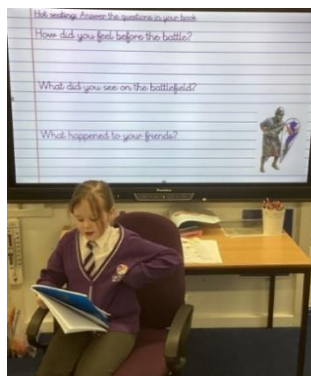
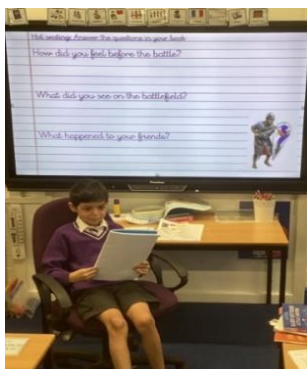
YEAR 3
