Have a great week and a brilliant summer all of you!

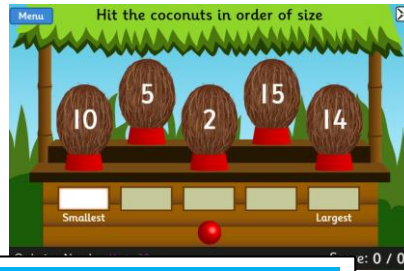

Can you write your name using pebbles or anything you have - could be sweets, cereal, lego etc?



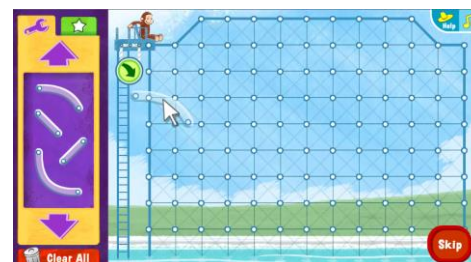
