# **Year 2 Sports Day Practise**


Year 2 have been working very hard in their PE lessons in preparation for their upcoming Sports day. We have been doing circuits to boost our fitness and have been practising team games to help with our teamwork in events like the relay.



### **Year 3 World of Plants**

This week year 3 have been broadening their knowledge on the world of plants in science lesson. We have learned about how seeds are dispersed in different ways and what different type of plants disperse their seeds.

We investigated through video watching and having a plant in our classroom what this might look like.



# **Year 4 Make Simple Series Circuits**

In science this week, Year 4 made simple series circuits as part of their electricity topic. The children were asked to create a circuit using a bulb, cell and wires to ensure the bulb lit up. We then started to add other components such as switches and tried different ways to make the bulb light up. The children thoroughly enjoyed having a go and discovered that a circuit must be complete for it to work. We discussed electrical currents and were surprised to discover that we could make a human circuit! We discovered that when we all held hands, electrons flow on our skin from one end of the energy stick to another. We were very surprised to discover that our skin is a conductor of electricity!













# **Year 5 Science Investigation**
